Study Island (K-5)



Study Island is a web-based standards mastery and test preparation program that is explicitly designed to help K-5th grade students master the content specified in state and Common Core standards and improve performance in core skill areas.

Follow the instructions below, in order to use the program:

1. Go to www.studyisland.com
2. Click Login button
3. Enter your username and password, and click "Submit".

Note: Username is first name.last name@Bldg Initials (John.Doe@EHS) and the password is your Student ID Number.
4. Click on the section tab (math, reading, etc.) that you wish to work on.
5. Click the "Pretest" in order to begin the pretest for the section. You must complete 10 pretest questions before moving on to the topics.
6. Once you complete the "Pretest," you may work through the remainder of the topics in any order you like. You must "pass" all topics before taking the "Post Test".
7. To pass a topic, you must satisfy the topic's passing requirements. A blue ribbon icon is displayed next to all passed topics.
8. Once you have passed all the topics in the section, you have to pass the "Post Test" for the section before the section is complete. Ignore this step if the section has no "Post Test".
